

Orientation Guidelines: Summer 2025

Welcome to the Orientation Program for Summer 2025. Please read through the following guidelines carefully to ensure a smooth and successful experience.

Dedicated Website: A dedicated website is available, containing all the information and updates regarding the Orientation Program. Students must check the site for the latest updates regularly.

Email Notices: Students who have received a DIU email address must check their official email regularly for important notices.

Registration Deadlines for Orientation Program: Students need to adhere to the deadlines for registering for cultural performances and sports activities in the Orientation Program.

Grooming and Selection: Registered students will undergo a grooming and selection process to qualify for stage performances. There are no alternative methods.

'Learn & Win' Quiz Competition: Participate in the "Learn & Win" Quiz competition to win cash prizes up to BDT 5000. Winners will be announced on stage during the Orientation Program. For details, keep your eyes on the Orientation website and DIU student email address.

Health and Well-being: We encourage students to get adequate sleep the night before the event to ensure participation with sound health and to avoid any health hazards.

Essentials to Carry: Students should carry a water bottle to hydrate themselves and an umbrella to get protection from the sun.

Dress Code: Students are encouraged to wear appropriate and decent attire.

Transportation: DIU students can use DIU transport by showing their admission money receipt. Route plans, bus stops, and timings will be shared on the orientation website and by email before the Orientation Program.

Punctuality: Students must be seated at Shadhinota Sommelon Kendra, the Orientation Program venue, at least 15 minutes before the start time

During the Program: Students must remain in the venue during the program and are not allowed to roam around. They must stay until the program concludes

Disciplinary Measures: The BNCC and Air Rover Scout of Daffodil University will maintain discipline. If you need to leave the venue urgently, provide a valid reason and justification to them.

Event Souvenirs and Food Coupons: Students should collect event souvenirs and food coupons **one day before** the Orientation Program from the Office of the Students' Affairs. No food will be served without a coupon. Food coupon distribution may be extended by an hour on the event day with proper justification and proof of not having collected it by the due date.

Food Distribution: Students must show their food coupon and collect food from the assigned food booth in an orderly manner. All should follow instructions from the central stage.
